**RESOLUTION**

**PROVIDING FOR THE RESTRICTION OF MOTORBOATS AND OTHER VESSELS ON  
LOWER LONG LAKE IN THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF BLOOMFIELD**

WHEREAS, the Township Board of the Charter Township of Bloomfield, Michigan, has received complaints of motorboat and other vessel use on Lower Long Lake; and

WHEREAS, the most current information accessible to the Township concerning Lower Long Lake indicates that the surface area of the lake is 184 acres and the perimeter is 5.1 miles. The maximum depth of the lake is 90 feet; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has determined that the use of motorboats and other vessels on Lower Long Lake in a manner inconsistent with the proposed Ordinance would be unsafe; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board is of the opinion that the restricted use of motorboats and other vessels on Lower Long Lake will serve to ensure a desirable quality of life for the residents of Bloomfield Township on Lower Long Lake.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of the Charter Township of Bloomfield hereby formally requests the assistance of the Department of Natural Resources to conduct a public hearing pursuant to the Marine Safety Act 3030 of 1967, on the issue of restricting motorboat and other vessel use in Lower Long Lake.
